2. Needs drums for drumline. Pep band has 2 division levels – advanced and beginner with 25 students and 20 drums – needs 5 more

5. Picture of uniform – put in Newsletter for donations

Roger Yamaguchi, CHS 1977– Tennis Coach

1. Started with 15 players now 58
2. Uses Jefferson Park tennis courts
3. 2016 – won D Division
4. 2017-2018 restructured and finished 4<sup>th</sup>

2. Go with football schedule
3. He rents gym at a church for practice
